Rules and Regulations

- 1. <u>Camping 1st Est</u> is open from June 1st to Labor Day or later if necessary, & Camping Green is open from June 1st to Sept 30th.
- 2. Registration is required for all campers.
- 3. The definition of a "camping group" is : 6 people (adults and children).
- 4. The camping <u>site</u> is for : <u>one</u> tent, <u>one</u> tent trailer, or <u>one</u> motorized vehicle for a maximum of 6 people per group. A cooking area may also be installed on the same site (ex : a tent trailer with a canvas covered area for a BBQ)
- 5. In case of emergency: alert or inform the reception office staff.
- On the date of departure, you are required to vacate the "Nature Tent" site at 10a.m. (Arrivals from 2p.m.) and for the camping sites at 11a.m. (Arrivals from 12 noon).
- 7. The owner/operator cannot be held responsible, in any case, by the tenant, subtenant &/or guests for damages caused by a partial or total lack of electricity, fire, theft, accidents, etc.
- 8. You must respect the posted speed limit of 15km/hr for the security of all campers.
- 9. Vehicles must be parked on the **gravelled section** of the camping site in order to preserve the grass/lawn.
- 10. The tenant must keep their site clean and proper at all times. Any destruction or damage of the terrain will be noted by the direction.
- 11. Open fires are permitted in the designated areas.
- 12. All campers using a vehicle must conform to the <u>Highway Safety Code</u> (Valid licence, plates, helmets, etc.).
- 13. Dogs are allowed on the camping site provided they are kept on a leash & do not cause any disturbance to the other occupants of the camping.
- 14. Installation of a domestic refridgerator on the outside of a trailer is prohibited.
- 15. Modifying a sump or installing a temporary or permanent septic system is prohibited.
- 16. All tenants are responsible for their guests and must have them leave the camping area at **lights-out(11p.m.)** or have them register for the night.
- 17. Only the registered tenant may park his vehicle on the site. You must advise your guests to use the parking beyond the barrier at the entry.
- 18. All the garbage must be collected in plastic bags and placed in the designated area for it.
- 19. The owner/operator (or representative) of the camping reserves the right to **refuse(expulse)** all tenants/visitors deemed non-conformant or undesireable (cause trouble, etc.).
- 20. The direction reserves the right to modify these rules/regulations without advance notice.
